In 1971, appointed to Royal Newcastle Hospital/John Hunter Hospital to start a new Nephrology Department. This was successfully achieved with establishment of Nephrology Unit, Dialysis Unit, Renal Transplant Unit and Renal Laboratory, with the additional ability of undertaking research.

The University of Newcastle School of Medicine and Public Health commenced in 1978, and active involvement in teaching and educating students was undertaken from the beginning. The role evolved as Conjoint Prof at School of Medicine and Public Health. The research items resulted in >90 publications in almost all fields of Nephrology.
